Background: In compliance with Ordinance 104-10 which provided that water connection fees (capacity Charges) be reviewed annually and adjusted to conform to changes in the construction costs as determined by the Engineering News Record (ENR) construction cost index. This ENR-CCI-LA index increased 4.2% from August, 13 to August, 14. The capacity charges, a component of the cost for a new water meter installation, are collected and the revenue is allocated toward

construction of capital facilities, such as tanks, pump stations and pipelines needed to provide service to the new demand on the system. A public hearing is required under Government Code Section §66016 (a). The proposed resolution sets the time and date of the hearing for October 24, 2014 at 2:10 p.m.
